

Acacia cultriformis

Large shrub 2mH x3mW. Grey triangular foliage and masses of golden flower balls in spring. Dry position in sun to part shade. Most draining soils. Long-lived attractive screen plant. Foliage good for floristry.

Acacia denticulosa

Sand Paper Wattle. Open shrub 1- 4mH. Long bright yellow rod flowers in spring. Grows in light sandy to draining clay soils. Prune to encourage branched habit. Drought hardy, frost tolerant once established.

Acacia flexifolia

Rounded shrub to 1.5mH x 2.5mW larger in open sites. Small narrow slightly bent foliage. Profuse small yellow flowers in late winter. Dry draining spot in full sun or part shade. Accepts extended dry periods. Prune as a low hedge.

Acacia implexa

Small tree to 4-6mH x 4mW. Long curved foliage. Pale yellow ball flowers in autumn and much curved and twisted pods. Draining soils in full or filtered sun. A hardy species which tolerates dryness.

Acacia polybotrya

Small to medium spreading shrub 1-2.5mH x 1-2.5mW with glaucous hairy leaves. Long racemes of bright yellow flowers in spring. For warm sunny spot in light to medium soils. Tolerates waterlogging for short periods

Acacia spectabilis

Mudgee wattle. Tall shrub to small tree 2-4mH x 2-3mW with weeping habit, silver bark & bluish-grey lacy leaves. Showy, bright gold flower balls Sept-Oct. For most well-drained soils in full sun. Good specimen plant. Drought hardy.

Allocasuarina diminuta subsp. diminuta

Large shrub or small tree 2-5mH x 2-5mW with red flowers on female plants and cones to 20mm long. Adaptable to a variety of soils, moist and dry conditions. Occurs Pilliga to Temora. Glossy Black Cockatoo food

Allocasuarina verticillata

Syn Casuarina stricta. Very attractive tree 4-8mH x 3-5mW. Rounded crown with weeping foliage. Female has fluffy flowers Mar-Dec and woody cones. Hardy in most sites and conditions. Glossy Black Cockatoo food.

Anigozanthos 'Yellow Gem'

Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant 1- 1.5mH x 1 -1.5mW with strap-like leaves. Tall stems of yellow flowers in spring. Requires well-drained soils in full or part sun with protection from heavy frosts.

Anigozanthos flavidus (Green)

Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant to 1mH x 1mW with thick strappy leaves. Tubular green flowers on 2m stems in Nov- Feb. For light to medium soils in partial to full sun. Recovers from frost damage.

Acacia deanei

Tall shrub 3mH x 3mW with ferny leaves and pale yellow flowers in summer and sporadic. Dry or moist draining sandy or clay soils in open position. Quick shade or erosion control.

Acacia fimbriata

Hardy small bushy tree 6mH x 5mW. Weeping narrow foliage fringed with small hairs. Brilliant yellow perfumed ball flowers in spring. Draining soils in sun or filtered shade. Attracts seed-eating birds.

Acacia floribunda

Large shrub to 3mH x 3mW with graceful dense dark green leaves. Scented cream rod flowers in early spring. Grows in a wide range of soils, even clay, likes extra moisture. Dappled shade, part or full sun. Fast growing screen.

Acacia podalyriifolia

Silvery grey tree 6mH x 5mW with rounded foliage. Massed golden flowers from autumn to spring and large grey pods. Moist well-drained or dry soils in sunny position. Prune for bushy habit. Quick growing and decorative. Foliage used for floristry.

Acacia rubida

Tall shrub or small tree 3-5mH x 3-5mW. Red stems and light green foliage, often with divided juvenile leaves present. Profuse yellow ball flowers in spring. Most soils in sun or part shade. Tolerates dryness, very frost hardy.

Acacia vestita

Beautiful weeping large shrub 3mH x 5mW. Hairy triangular grey-green foliage and golden flowers in winter and spring. Hardy in most soils in partial or full sun. Feature plant or hedge. Recommended.

Allocasuarina gymnanthera

Mallee shrub to 2mH x 2mW with needle like foliage and woody cones which attract black cockatoos. Full or part sun in dry sites. Drought and frost hardy when established. Important food for the Glossy Black Cockatoo.

Anigozanthos 'Orange Cross'

Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant 1.2mH x 1.5mW, strappy leaves. Vivid orange flowers late spr & sum. Moist to dry well-drained soils, full to part sun. Recovers from frost damage. Water weekly in dry winter.

Anigozanthos flavidus (Bright Red)

Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant to 1mH x 1mW with thick strappy leaves. Tubular vibrant red flowers on 2m stems Nov- Feb. For light to medium soils in partial to full sun. Recovers from frost damage.

Anigozanthos flavidus (Pink)

Kangaroo Paw. Clumping plant to 0.7mH x 0.7mW with thick strappy leaves. Tubular pink flowers on 1m stems in Nov- Feb. For light to medium soils in partial to full sun. Recovers from frost damage.



Arthropodium sp. B

Vanilla Lily. 0.3mH x 0.3mW. Grass like leaves, pretty pale lilac flowers on long stems to 0.8mH Nov-Feb. Anthers pale green. Most conditions in shade or part sun. Dies back in winter. Tubers can be eaten. Good in pots.

Baloskion tetraphyllus

Creeping plant with erect stems to 1mH with finely divided plume-like branches. Grow in full sun in damp soil near or in water. Feature foliage plant for pots, and floral arrangements.

Banksia baxteri

Birds' Nest Banksia. A dense spreading shrub 3-4mH x 3mW, triangular lobed leaves. Showy lemony flower cones spring- autumn. For well-drained light to heavy soils in partial to full sun. Frost protection when young.

Banksia ericifolia (dwarf)

Medium bushy shrub to 1.5mH x 1mW. Bright green linear leaves, cylindrical orange flowers. Hardy screen or hedge plant in most positions with moist well-drained soil. Bird attracting.

Banksia menziesii

Small tree to 6-7mH. Narrow toothed leaves. Silvery-red flowers with golden styles in spring. Needs well-drained light to medium soil with added lime. Full or part sun. Difficult in Canberra. Specialist plant. Try in large tub.

Banksia petiolaris

A spreading prostrate shrub 0.3-0.6mH x 2- 3mW, horizontal branches, large wavy toothed leaves. Flowerheads purple becoming yellow Aug-March girt the plant. For well-drained soils in dappled shade, partial to full sun.

Banksia robur

Swamp Banksia. Medium shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Attractive reddish new growth. Stiff oaklike leaves, greenish flowers ageing to yellow all year. Sunny position. Adapts to a variety of sites and soils. Likes extra water but will withstand quite dry periods.

Banksia speciosa

Showy Banksia. Many branching shrub to 4m. Very long leaves with triangular lobes. Showy lemon cream flower cones spring- autumn. For well-drained light to heavy soils in partial to full sun. Frost protection when young.

Banksia undata var. splendens

syn Dryandra praemorsa. Bushy medium shrub 2-4mH x 2 -4mW with long, toothed foliage. Yellow or pink flowers in spring. Prefers well-drained soil in dappled shade or part sun. Useful screening plant. Bird attracting.

Brachyscome multifida (pink)

Small plant 0.15mH x 0.6mW. Rounded ground cover. Green finely divided leaves, pink daisy flowers during spring, summer and autumn. Moist soils in partial shade. For best show prune away old stems in late winter.

Austrostipa densiflora

Syn Stipa densiflora. A decorative grass to about 1.5mH. Dense and attractive bronze flower spikes in spring and summer. For dry sites in sun or semi-shade. Feature with rocks or alone.

Banksia baueri

Possum Banksia. Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Large serrated leaves. Very large woolly flowers, which have lemon styles with grey tips, persist for many months. Well drained sunny position. Very ornamental.

Banksia burdettii

A much branched medium sized shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Spectacular bright orange flowers are borne at the end of branches. Prefers sandy or well drained acid soils. Drought and frost tolerant when established

Banksia marginata

Large shrub to small tree 3-5mH x 2-3mW. Silver backed foliage. Yellow flowers in autumn and winter. Most well-drained positions. Tolerates some shade. Hardy banksia.

Banksia occidentalis

A much branched medium sized shrub to 3mH x 1.5mW, without a lignotuber. Spectacular bright orange/red flowers. Prefers sandy or well drained acid soils. Drought and frost tolerant when established. Light regular prune.

Banksia pilostylis

Bushy small shrub to 1.2mH x 1.5mW with slender toothed leaves. Creamy yellow scented flowers to 12cm in spring/summer. Needs good drainage and full sun with frost protection in its first year.

Banksia serrata

Gnarled tree 5-10mH x 5mW with attractive bark and dark green serrated leaves, silver below. Grey-green to yellow flowers in winter, spring and summer. For dry or moist well-drained soils in full or filtered sun.

Banksia spinulosa

Bushy shrub 2-4mH x 2-4mW with narrow toothed leaves, pale below. Honey coloured flowers with purplish spines in autumn/winter. Suits well-drained acid soils in sun or part shade. Suitable under Eucalypts. Bird plant.

Brachychiton rupestris

Bottle Tree. Tree with swollen trunk to 20mH. Compound juvenile leaves and lanceolate adult leaves and small insignificant flowers. Most soils and aspects. Feature plant. Suits a pot, indoor or out.

Callistemon pachyphyllus

Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with thick dull green oblong leaves. Bright red flower spikes in spring and autumn. Will accept most soils and bad drainage but needs full sun. Prune heavily after flowering. Extremely hardy.



Callistemon pinifolius (red)

Open medium shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW with very narrow sharply pointed leaves. Red flower spikes in summer. Full sun. Hardy and adaptable to most conditions, even poor soils. Prune for shape regularly after flowering.

Callitris glaucophylla

White Cypress Pine. Conifer 15mH x 10mW. Tall and slender. Ornamental juvenile foliage, woody cones. Sunny draining site. Resists drought. Hardy shade tree. Fast growing. Great for bonsai.

Calotis cuneifolia

Low spreading daisy to 0.3mH x 0.5mW with wedgeshaped leaves and hairy branches. Mauve flowers most of year, small burr fruits. Hardy in most soils. Partial to full sun. Prune old stems in late winter. Rockery plant.

Casuarina cunninghamiana

River Sheoak. Shelter or shade tree to 20mH x 12mW. Needle-like foliage, woody cones. Flowers Dec-Jan. Most soils, well- drained or damp, full sun. Grows on riverbanks. Controls soil by suckering. Very fast growing.

Chrysocephalum apiculatum

Perennial herb 0.2-0.4mH x 0.5-2mW. Variable, green or grey leaves. Clusters of small golden flowers all the year. Needs reasonable drainage and sun. Good in massed plantings. Can be suckering.

Correa 'Kiss me Kate'

Small dense shrub 0.6mH x 2mW with rounded leaves. Pink bells in autumn and winter. For draining clay soils in moist or dry conditions in part sun or shade. Long flowering, attracts birds. Prune regularly.

Correa 'White Lies'

Small dense shrub 0.4mH x 2mW with oval leaves. Pure white flared bells in autumn and winter. For draining soils in moist or dry conditions in full sun or shade. Attracts birds. Prune regularly.

Bred by Bilby Blooms

Correa glabra (red)

Rounded shrub 1.2-1.8mH x 1.2-2mW. Smooth glossy leaves, red bell flowers in winter. Well-drained soil in half or full shade. Good screen, attracts birds.

Derwentia arenaria

Small to medium shrub 0.6-1.5mH x 1- 2mW with narrow leaves. Pale to deep violet-blue flowers are profuse and conspicuous from Sept-May. For moderately well-drained acidic soils in sun or semi-shade. Rare plant.

Dianella 'Uralla'

Mini Flax Lily. Tufted plant with flax- like leaves, suckering to form clumps to 1mW. Bright blue flowers on branched stems, bright blue fruits. Very hardy. Ideal garden plant especially for rockeries, great border plant.

Callistemon viminalis

Weeping tree 6mH x 3mW with narrow leaves. Silky new growth. Long red brushes in spring, summer and autumn. Prune for autumn flowers. Takes wide range of soils in full sun. Not for frost hollows.

Calothamnus gilesii

Medium shrub 2-4mH x 2-4mW with fine leaves. Clusters of red flowers with gold anthers in spring and summer. Adaptable to most soils in full sun. Drought and frost hardy. Suitable for windbreak or screen. Bird attracting plant.

Carex appressa

Tall Sedge. A clumping tussock which may grow to 0.8mH with brown flowerheads in spring and summer. It grows well in most positions even water logging, in full sun. It can handle dry periods. Strong roots good for erosion control.

Chamelaucium 'Paddy's Pink'

Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with fine light green leaves. Crowded blueish pink flowers late spring, early summer. Light to medium draining soils in sun or part shade. Great cut flower. Drought and frost hardy.

Correa 'Firebird'

Upright shrub 1-2mH x 1.5mW. Oval hairy leaves. Orangered flowers with beige throat Mch-Sept. Likes draining light to heavy soils. Favours dappled shade to partial sun, will tolerate full sun & full shade.

Correa 'Redex'

Small shrub 1mH x .8m. Interesting small rounded leaves, pink/red and yellow flowers throughout cooler months. Hardy plant in draining soils in full or filtered sun. Bird plant.

Correa 'White Tips'

Shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW . Very pretty pink bells with white tips in autumn and winter. For draining soils in moist or dry conditions in full sun or shade. Attracts birds. Prune regularly.

Crinum flaccidum Darling Lily

Vigourously growing lily once the season warms with large white clustered scented flowers on a robust stem to 0.6m mid to late Summer. Edible bulbuls occur after flowering, Winter dormant. Prefers sunny clay position

Derwentia perfoliata

Perennial to 0.6mH x 1mW with arching stems of grey green ovate leaves. Terminal sprays of bright blue flowers in summer. Full sun to part shade. Very hardy. Prune off old stems late winter.

Dianella revoluta

Spreading Flax Lily. Tufted plant with flax- like leaves, suckering to form clumps to 2.5mW. Bright blue flowers on branched stems, bright blue fruits. Very hardy. Ideal garden plant esp. for rockeries.



Dianella tasmanica

Flax Lily. Tufted plant with thick strap leaves to 1mH. Blue flowers in long spikes spring-summer followed by stunning purple berries. Wide range of soils including heavy clay. Use throughout the garden as a contrast plant. Very hardy.

Eremophila glabra 'Belalla Gold'

Prostrate plant 0.2mH x 2mW with bright green leaves, abundant yellow flowers from autumn to spring. Bird & bee attractant. Drought and frost tolerant. For draining soils in full or part sun.

Eremophila longifolia

Weeping upright shrub to 3mH x 3mW. Hairy reddish flowers are seen throughout the year, particularly spring to summer. Will grow in alkaline clay soils to well drained acid. Can sucker, drought and frost hardy, fire retardant.

Eremophila maculata (hot pink)

Small spreading shrub 1mH x 1.5mW with small often sticky leaves and tubular hot pink flowers in winter-spring. For heavier soils with good drainage in part to full sun. Tip prune for bushy growth.

Eucalyptus 'Delicious'

Mallee 1.5m-3mH x 1-3mW. This small ornamental eucalypt has beautiful huge red coloured buds and red flowers throughout the year. Drought and frost tolerant on non water logging soils. Prune hard to rejuvenate.

Eucalyptus 'Jaq Joy'

Mallee to 4.5mH. E. youngiana x E. macrocarpa. Bark smooth and orange brown with pale blue green leaves. Spectacular clusters of large salmon red flowers. Tolerates dryness & frost. Needs reasonable drainage. **Bred by Bilby Blooms**

Eucalyptus 'Silver Princess'

Eucalyptus caesia subsp. magna. Mallee 8-15mH x 3 -5mW, decorative bark, pendulous branches, glaucous foliage & large red flowers June-Nov. For fairly welldrained acid to slightly alkaline soils, sunny site. Frost protection when young.

Eucalyptus eximia nana

Yellow Bloodwood. A tree to 5mH x 3mW with a dense canopy and large bluish adult leaves. Showy cream flowers follow very attractive green buds in spring. For draining acidic soils. Not for frost hollows.

Eucalyptus macrocarpa hybrid

Upright mallee shrub 2-3mH x 2-3mW, with opposite silvery leaves. The large silver buds, in threes, are followed by showy red flowers (10cm) throughout year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant

Eucalyptus pyriformis (red)

Pear-fruited Mallee. Mallee 2-5mH x 3- 4mW, smooth bark & pale to mid green leaves. Red flowers with grey buds. Draining soils in a hot site. Frost protect when young. Good in a pot.

Eremophila 'Passionate Lady'

Large shrub to 3mH x 3mW (growth is restricted by pruning). Linear bright- green leaves, crimson flowers with dark spotted throat Sept-May. For a hot, sunny site on heavy soils. Frost and drought tolerant.

Eremophila glabra (low grey)

Small plant to 0.5mH to 1.5mW with grey leaves. Masses of yellow flowers from winter to summer and sporadic. For most draining soils in full to part sun. Drought and frost hardy. Can be pruned hard.

Eremophila maculata 'Pink Passion'

Shrub 1mH x 1mW. Small leaves, tubular rich pink flowers in winter-spring. Best in heavier soils with drainage in part to full sun. Provides nectar for birds. Frost and very drought hardy.

Eremophila maculata x racemosa

Medium upright shrub to 1.5mH. Yellow then orange buds open to pink flowers with a white fringe inside the throat of the flower. For a wide range of soils in full to part sun. Prune to shape. Bird attractant.

Eucalyptus 'Jaq Gem'

Mallee to 4.5mH. E. youngiana x E. macrocarpa. Bark smooth and orange brown with pale blue green leaves. Spectacular clusters of large cream/yellow/red flowers. Tolerates dryness & frost. Needs reasonable drainage.

Eucalyptus 'Little Princess'

Mallee to 3mH x 3mW. Decorative bark, upright habit, grey foliage & large pink flowers April- Sept. Draining acid to slightly alkaline soils. Full to part sun. Protect from heavy frost when young. Bred by Bilby Blooms

Eucalyptus cinerea

Argyle Apple. Medium tree 8-15mH x 8-15mW. Attractive glaucous cordate juvenile foliage, and glaucous adult foliage. White flowers Oct-Dec. Adapts to most well-drained soils. Responds to hard pruning and coppicing. Great foliage.

Eucalyptus macrocarpa

Sprawling mallee shrub 1-4mH x 1-4mW, with opposite large silvery leaves. The glaucous buds are followed by showy pink- red flowers (10cm) throughout the year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant

Eucalyptus pulveralenta

Eucalyptus pyriformis x macrocarpa

Mallee 2-3mH x 3- 4mW, smooth bark & pale to mid green leaves. Large red flowers. Draining soils in a sunny site. Not for frost hollows. Good in a pot. Prune hard to keep compact.



Eucalyptus sideroxylon 'Pretty Pink'

Tree 3-8mH x 2-4-W, ornamental blue green foliage, black bark & attractive pink flowers May-Oct. For a wide range of soils conditions. Frost, drought and salt tolerant.

Eucalyptus youngiana

Mallee 1.5m-4mH x 1-3mW. This small ornamental eucalypt is known for the beautiful huge buds and red flowers throughout the year. Drought and frost tolerant on non water logging soils. Prune hard to rejuvenate.

Grevillea 'Amethyst'

Decorative small shrub to 1mH with fine prickly foliage. Showy pink flowers in spring & summer. For most soils in sun or part sun. Good for small birds.

Grevillea 'Carpet Queen'

Dense groundcover 0.3-0.6mH x 1-1.8mW, with small deep-green leaves. Yellow/apricot flowers mainly in spring. For well-drained light to medium soils in full or part sun. Give low phosphorus fertilizer in spring. Good bird plant.

Grevillea 'Poorinda Rondeau'

Medium shrub 1.5-2mH x 1.5-3mW, with shiny dark-green oval leaves. Showy, profuse bright pinkish-red flowers July-Nov. For most well-drained acid soils in sun. Hardy to most frosts. Prune lightly for good shape.

Grevillea arenaria

Dense stiff shrub 1.5-3mH x 2-3mW. Grey- green foliage and red, pink, green, yellow or orange spider flowers over a long period. Hardy in all aspects and soils except wet. Attractive to birds.

Grevillea johnsonii

Erect shrub to 4mH x 3mW with fine pinnate foliage. Large red waxy flowers in winter and spring. Needs draining soil in sun, part sun or shade. Showy large plant rarely seen in cultivation.

Grevillea semperflorens

An early hybrid Grevillea to 2mH x 2mW. Pink and apricot flowers a seen most of the year on arching branches of grey green leaves. Tolerates acid neutral clay or loam soils. Frost and drought hardy

Grevillea x gaudichaudii

Vigorous ground cover 0.1mH x 3mW. Oak- like leaves, dark red toothbrush flowers in late spring and summer. Reliable in well- drained sunny position. Recommended.

Hakea 'Molly Lace'

H. francisiana x coriacea. Erect shrub 2.5mH x 2.5mW with long grey leaves. Attractive spikes of pretty pink flowers in winter to spring. Dry sunny site in light-med soils with good drainage. Prune when young for windy sites. Attracts birds. Drought, lime and frost hardy.

Eucalyptus staigeriana

Lemon scented Ironbark. Slender upright small eucalypt to 3mH. Crushed leaves give a sweet lemon smell, can be used in cooking/teas. Accepts most soils to heavy loams. Frost, wind and drought tolerant.

Ficinia nodosa

Syn Isolepis n-. Knobby Club Rush. Small slow spreading perennial 0.5-1.5mH x 0.6-2mW, green upright stems. Dense globular red-brown flower heads just below the stem tip. For moist soils (takes dry times) in sun to part shade.

Grevillea 'Carol Ann'

Decumbent spreading shrub to 2mW. Dense non prickly foliage with an occasional upright branch. Dark red flowers are borne most of the year. For sun or semi-shade in most draining soils. Frost and drought hardy. Good for birds.

Grevillea 'Lemon Supreme'

Fast growing medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Produces masses of lemon spider flowers from Winter to Spring. Tolerates a wide range of soils including clay and lime. Bird attracting. Drought and frost tolerant.

Grevillea 'Winter Delight'

Hardy groundcover to 0.3mH x 1.5mW. Lovely small soft grey leaves with clusters of red and cream flowers in winter and spring. Tolerates clay and well drained soils. Drought and frost hardy.

Grevillea beadleana

Dense spreading shrub 1.5mH x 2.5mW with soft, greygreen, much divided leaves. Dark-red toothbrush flowers most of year. Most well-drained soils in sun or dappled shade. Screen or hedge, attracts birds.

Grevillea juniperina 'Molonglo'

Low spreading shrub 0.5mH x 3mW with small narrow prickly foliage. Apricot flowers in spring and summer. Good drainage in most soils and full sun for best flowering. Vigorous grower. Good ground cover. Bird attracting.

Grevillea willisii

Spreading shrub 2.5mH x 3mW. Prickly divided grey leaves, spikes of white 'toothbrush' flowers in spring and summer. Full or filtered sun with reasonable drainage. Hardy quick growing screen or tall ground cover.

Hakea 'Double Gate'

H. francisiana x bucculenta. Erect shrub 3mH x 3mW with long leaves. Attractive spikes of hot pink flowers in winter to spring. Dry sunny site in light-med soils with good drainage. Prune when young for windy sites. Attracts birds. Drought, lime and frost hardy.

Hakea 'Morgan'

H. bucculenta x francissiana. Erect shrub 3mH x 3mW with long leaves. Attractive hot pink flower spikes winter - spring. Dry sunny site in draining light-med soils. Prune when young in windy sites. Attracts birds. Drought, lime and frost hardy.



Hakea 'Tessa'

H. multilineata x grammatophylla A variable shrub to 2.5mH, with narrow grey-green leaves to 16cm long Showy crimson pink scented flowers appear in the leaf axils from March to August. Draining soils in a sunny to part shaded site. Drought and frost hardy.

Hakea macraeana

Large shrub 4mH x 3.5mW. Soft needle like foliage. Cream perfumed flowers in leaf axils in spring. Most draining soils in full sun to semi-shade. Excellent hardy screen plant. Rare and endangered.

Hakea nitida

A medium shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Firm broad leaves have sharp teeth which help make this plant a good screener. Masses of perfumed white flowers occur in late winter. Full to partial sun in draining soils. Frost hardy

Hakea orthorrhyncha

Rounded shrub to 1.5-2.5mH x 1-3mW with long needle like leaves. Spectacular red flowers on older wood in winter and spring. Tolerant of a wide range of soils, moist or dry, in full or filtered sun. Showy in flower.

Hakea purpurea

Medium shrub 1.5-2mH x 1.5-2mW with narrow leaves. Red, purple-red or pinkish flowers in winter and spring. Best in well- drained soils in sun. Tolerant of drought and moderately heavy frosts. Bird attracting.

Hardenbergia violacea (pink)

Groundcover or trailing plant to 1.5m-2mW with lanceshaped leaves. Masses of pink flowers in spring. Full sun to partly shaded well-drained position. May be pruned hard. Some frost damage. Not for frost hollows.

Homoranthus papillatus

A sculptural shrub to 1mH x 1- 2mW with horizontal branches and grey- green linear leaves. Yellow flowers in late spring. Hardy in most soils and aspects. Foliage and habit are a feature. Excellent for bonsai.

Indigofera adesmiifolia

Open spreading shrub 1.5mH x 1mW with small blue-green leaves on flattened stems. Pink pea flowers in spring. For dry or moist well-drained soils in part sun. Prune after flowering.

Isopogon anethifolius

Medium shrub 1-2.5mH x 1-2.5mW. Divided leaves with very narrow leaflets. Yellow globe-shaped flowers July-Dec. Most acidic soils suitable, not waterlogged. Some shade. Tip prune young plants. Good cut flower.

Isopogon dawsonii

A shrub to 2.5mH x 1-2mW, with grey- green, much divided leaves. Prominent creamy-white heads of flowers in spring. For most well-drained soils and light overhead cover. Prune lightly.

Hakea coriacea

Erect shrub 5mH x 3mW with long leaves. Attractive spikes of cream & red flowers in spring. Dry spot in light-med soils with good drainage. Sun or part shade. Drought and frost hardy when established.

Hakea multilineata (maroon & cream)

Outstanding large upright shrub 3-4mH x 2mW. Long narrow stiff leaves and spikes of vivid maroon and cream flowers in winter and spring. Draining soils in filtered or full sun. Grow with other plants. Bird plant & tall hedge.

Hakea obtusa

Rounded shrub to 2mH x 1.5mW, with blunt elliptical leaves. Copious bright pink flowers on old growth in spring. For well-drained soils and most aspects. Prune lightly. Good ornamental screen plant.

Hakea petiolaris

Tall shrub 3mH x 2mW with rounded grey-green leaves. Green/pink sea urchin flowers aging to cream/maroon in autumn and winter. Needs reasonable drainage and plenty of sun. Prune lightly. Very ornamental.

Hardenbergia violacea

Ground cover or trailing plant to 1.5mW with lance-shaped leaves. Masses of purple flowers in spring. Full sun to partly shaded draining position. May be pruned hard. Not for frost hollows.

Hardenbergia violacea (white)

Groundcover or trailing plant to 1.5m-2mW with lanceshaped leaves. Masses of white flowers in spring. Full sun to partly shaded well-drained position. May be pruned hard. Some frost damage. Not for frost hollows.

Hovea lanceolata

Open shrub 2mH x 1mW. Narrow leaves. Blue pea flowers in late winter or spring. Likes excellent drainage, cool root run and some overhead shade. Light pruning beneficial.

Indigofera australis

Open spreading shrub 1.5-2.5mH x 1-2mW with bluegreen leaves. Mauve-pink pea flowers in spring. For dry or moist well- drained soils in part sun. Prune after flowering. Colonizer.

Isopogon cuneatus x buxifolius

Compact shrub 1.5mH x 1mW. The light green leaves and masses of terminal silvery pink cone flowers make this a stunning cut flower and garden plant. For a open well drained acid neutral soils. Moderate drought and frost hardy. Prune after flowering

Isotoma fluviatilis

Small creeping plant spreading to 0.5mW with small round crowded foliage and blue star flowers in spring and summer. Wet sunny position. Suit poolside, boggy sites or in a pot.



Kennedia procurrens

Groundcover to 1.5-3mW with round leaves in threes. Lovely large purple pea flowers bourne above from November to March. Adapts to a wide range of soils. Prune lightly. Frost hardy.

Kunzea parvifolia

Spreading plant 2mH x 2mW with tiny heath like foliage. Very pretty mauve fluffy flowers in spring. For most soils in full or filtered sun. Spring spectacle. Very hardy.

Leionema elatius x lamprophyllum

Medium shrub to 1.5mH X 1.5mW, with small round dark green leaves. Heads of white flowers in winter/spring. Suitable for draining soils in sun and dappled shade. Wonderful small hedging plant.

Lomandra longifolia (grey leaf)

A dense tussock plant 0.5-1mH x 0.6-1mW. Creamy, often fragrant flowers in Aug-Dec and then brown shiny fruits. For most well- drained soils with some sun. Feature with shrubs or grasses.

Melaleuca lateritia

Erect shrub to 2mH x 1mW with small linear leaves. Large orange-red brush flowers in late spring and summer. Hardy in well- drained soils, but likes lots of water. Flowers best in full sun.

Melaleuca thymifolia

Small rounded shrub to 1mH x 1mW with small grey elliptic foliage. Purple, pink or white claw flowers in late spring to autumn. Hardy plant in sunny site. Enjoys moist position but tolerates dry. Prune after flowering.

Myoporum parvifolium

Prostrate ground cover to 1.5-2mW with narrow fleshy leaves. White star flowers in spring and summer. Hardy in most soils in a well-drained sunny to semi-shaded position. Attractive hardy plant.

Philotheca 'Winter Rouge'

Small shrub .8mH x .8mW with slightly warty foliage. A profusion of white flowers follow pretty pink buds from winter to spring. For draining neutral to acid soils in sun to part shade. Prune to keep bushy.

Poa labillardieri

Tussock forming grass to 0.8mH with narrow greyish leaves. Plume-like heads of flowers on long stems. Will flourish in most situations. Frost hardy

Prostanthera sp. Dunedoo Gap

Upright shrub to 1mH x 1mW with small aromatic hairy leaves, sometimes with maroon tinge. Mauve to purple flowers in spring. Light to medium draining soils in full sun to semi-shade. Bee attracting.

Kunzea ambigua (prostrate)

Low growing 0.5mH x 1.5mW. Narrow leaves, white fluffy fragrant flowers in crowded clusters along stems in spring and summer. Hardy in most soils with good drainage in full or part sun. Attracts butterflies.

Kunzea pomifera

Muntrie - Prostrate woody shrub, spreads to 1.5mW, with small shiny round leaves and feathery white flowers in late spring. Purplish edible berries. Needs full or part sun and reasonable drainage. Popular bush food plant.

Leptospermum 'Pink Cascade'

Small shrub 0.5-1mH x 1-1.5mW, dark green pointed leaves. Reddish buds open to pink flowers in spring & often in autumn. It is adaptable in most soils in sun & semishade. May be clipped or pruned.

Melaleuca elliptica

Medium shrub to 2.5mH x 2.5mW with small elliptic leaves. Burgundy bottlebrush flowers Nov-March. Wide range of well- drained soils in a hot sunny site, tolerating some shade. Good screening plant. Prune to shape.

Melaleuca radula

Medium shrub to 2.5mH x 2.5mW, linear green leaves. Profuse and showy mauve- pink flowers in spring. For medium to heavy soils in a warm, sunny spot. Drought hardy. Not for frost hollows.

Mentha satureioides

Clumping ground cover herb. Small white to lilac flowers summer & autumn. For sun or shade in moisture retentive soils. Good in pots. Prune to rejuvenate.

Pandorea pandorana 'Ruby Belle'

Twining climber with glossy oval leaves. Red/maroon bell flowers mainly in spring. Well-composted soils in some shade. Fast-growing. Prune well. Some frost damage when young or in heavy frosts. Ideal screen.

Pittosporum angustifolium

Previously P. phylliraeoides. A weeping small tree 3-8mH x 1.5-3mW, pendent green leaves. Flowers scented, cream to yellow June- Nov, followed by showy fruits. For most soils in a shady or sunny site. Frost hardy.

Prostanthera granitica

A spreading shrub 0.6mH x 2mW with small harsh leaves. Showy purple flowers from Aug-Dec. Likes a well-drained soil with dappled shade to partial sun. Some overhead cover appreciated. Prune after flowering.

Pycnosorus globosus

Syn Craspedia globosa. Drumsticks. Robust tufty plant to $0.3\text{mH} \times 0.3$ -0.5mW with silvery, linear leaves. Large yellow flower heads to 0.8mH in spring & summer. For most soils in sun.



Rhagodia spinescens

Spreading grey leaved plant 0.5m-1mH x 2mW with fire resistant foliage. Grows in most soils in sunny sites. Responds to pruning. Good low maintenance hedge or ground cover. Toughy. Contrast plant. Edible berries.

Spyridium scortechinii

Syn Cryptandra scortechinii. Rounded shrub 0.7mH x 0.6mW with narrow oval foliage. Woolly heads of white flowers with shiny brown bracts in late winter to spring. Well-drained soil in full sun or half shade.

Tetragonia tetragonioides

Native Sinach. Prostrate sprawling shrub 0.5-1mH by 2mW. This bush tucker plant is like spinach, blanch before eating. It grows throughout the year, regular harvesting keeps plant vigourous. Draining soils full sun to shade.

Thelionema caespitosum (white)

Tufted plant with grass-like leaves 0.3m long. White star flowers on slender branched stems in summer. Relatively well- drained position in good sunlight. Does well in containers or open ground.

Thomasia sarotes

Low shrub 0.8H x 1mW with rough textured grey leaves. Very pretty pink/purple small pendulous flowers in spring & autumn. For light to medium soils in sun to semi-shade. Attractive in containers or rockery.

Viola silicestris (blue)

Sandstone Violet. Small spreading ground cover forming extensive mats in damp areas. Round leaves. Blue flowers for long periods. Hardy in full sun to full shade. Dies back in winter. Useful for hanging baskets.

Westringia fruticosa 'Zena'

Small shrub to 0.75mH x 1mW. Grey-green foliage with white flowers mainly in spring. Hardy in most soils in full sun or partial shade. Suitable for shrubbery or low hedge.

Sollya heterophylla Blue

A vigorous climber or twining shrub, to 3mH.Lovely blue bell flowers in clusters throughout year, mainly July to March followed by fleshy green fruits. Accepts moderate to good drainage in alkaline and acid soils. Frost hardy.

Swainsona galegifolia (burgundy)

Upright plant to 1.5mH with many stems of pinnate leaves. Sprays of burgundy pea flowers spr/sum/aut. For most soils (not wet) in sun. Prune old stems after flowering.

Thelionema caespitosum (blue)

Tufted plant with grass-like leaves 0.3m long. Deep blue star flowers on slender branched stems in summer. Relatively well- drained position in good sunlight. Containers or open ground.

Thelionema grande

Tufted plant to 1.2mH x 0.3mW, with broad strappy leaves. Blue star-like flowers appear on slender branched stems in spring. For light to medium soils in sun or part shade. Very frost hardy.

Viola hederacea

Native Violet. Small spreading ground cover forming extensive mats in damp areas. Round leaves. White and purple violet- shaped flowers for long periods. Full sun to part shade. Dies back in winter. Useful for hanging baskets.

Westringia fruticosa 'Smokie'

Small shrub to 0.6-1.3mH x 1.5mW. Silver- grey leaves with cream edges, white flowers in spring and summer. Hardy for most conditions in full or part sun. Very attractive rockery plant.
