Acacia 'Bilby Blue' Large shrub

Large shrub 3-mH x 3mW. Attractive grey green foliage. Large, bright yellow ball flowers in spring. Full or filtered sun in draining soils, tolerates limestone. Spectacular plant. **Bred by Bilby Blooms**

Acacia caesiella Tree

Showy small tree, may grow to 6mH x 3mW, but probably less. Mallee habit. Narrow curved foliage and golden globular flowers in spring. Adaptable to most situations.

Acacia cultriformis Large shrub

Large shrub 2mH x 3mW. Grey triangular foliage and masses of golden flower balls in spring. Dry position in sun to part shade. Most draining soils. Long-lived attractive screen plant. Foliage good for floristry.

Acacia denticulosa Medium shrub

Sand Paper Wattle. Open shrub 1- 4mH. Long bright yellow rod flowers in spring. Grows in light sandy to draining clay soils. Prune to encourage branched habit. Drought hardy, frost tolerant once established.

Acacia flexifolia Small shrub

Rounded shrub to 1.5mH x 2.5mW larger in open sites. Small narrow slightly bent foliage. Profuse small yellow flowers in late winter. Dry well-drained spot, full or filtered sun. Accepts extended dry periods. Prune.

Acacia implexa Tree

Small tree to 4-6mH x 4mW. Long curved foliage. Pale yellow ball flowers in autumn and much curved and twisted pods. Draining soils in full or filtered sun. A hardy species which tolerates dryness.

Acacia pravissima (prostrate) Small shrub

Very attractive cascading shrub to 0.6mH x 3-5mW. Profuse, scented, bright yellow flowers in spring. For a variety of soils and conditions, prefers partial to full sun. Prune when young for dense cover.

Acacia vestita Large shrub

Beautiful weeping large shrub 3mH x 5mW. Hairy triangular grey-green foliage and golden flowers in winter and spring. Hardy in most soils in partial or full sun. Feature plant or hedge. Recommended.

Allocasuarina diminuta subsp. diminuta Large shrub

Large shrub or small tree 2-5mH x 2-5mW with red flowers on female plants and cones to 20mm long. Adaptable to a variety of soils, moist and dry conditions. Occurs Pilliga to Temora.

Anigozanthos 'Bilby Pink' Grasses and clumping plants
Kangaroo Paw. Clumping plant to 0.7mH x 0.7mW with thick strappy leaves. Tubular pink flowers on 1m stems in Nov- Feb. For light to medium soils in partial to full sun. Recovers from frost damage. Bred by Bilby Blooms

Acacia aneura Tree

Mulga. Small tree/large shrub to 4mH x 2mW, often multi-stemmed. Narrow greyish phyllodes and yellow rod flowers in spring and after rain. Most draining soils in full sun. Hardy plant for dry areas.

Acacia cheelii Tree

Erect or spreading large shrub to 6mH x 3mW with dense foliage. Long curved phyllodes and golden rod flowers in spring. Sunny well-drained site in dry light to medium soil. Handsome screen for cold climate.

Acacia deanei Tree

Tall shrub 3mH x 3mW with ferny leaves and pale yellow flowers in summer and sporadic. Dry or moist draining sandy or clay soils in open position. Quick shade or erosion control.

Acacia fimbriata Tree

Hardy small bushy tree 6mH x 5mW. Weeping narrow foliage fringed with small hairs. Brilliant yellow perfumed ball flowers in spring. Draining soils in sun or filtered shade. Attracts seed-eating birds.

Acacia hakeoides Large shrub

Rounded shrub to 2mH x 2mW, green long oblong phyllodes. Yellow ball flowers in winter and easily harvested pods. Very hardy in sun or part shade on most soils. Great bushtucker seed after roasting

Acacia podalyriifolia Tree

Silvery grey tree 6mH x 5mW with rounded foliage. Massed golden flowers from autumn to spring and large grey pods. Moist well-drained or dry soils in sunny position. Prune for bushy habit. Quick growing and decorative. Foliage used for floristry.

Acacia rubida Large shrub

Tall shrub or small tree 3-5mH x 3-5mW. Red stems and light green foliage, often with divided juvenile leaves present. Profuse yellow ball flowers in spring. Most soils in sun or part shade. Tolerates dryness, very frost hardy.

Acacia victoriae Medium shrub

Erect or spreading prickly shrub, 2-7mH x 2- 5mW, dark grey bark and thorns at base of straight phyllodes. Pale yellow or white ball flowers in spr, and wide flat pods. Sun or part shade in moist sand or clay soils.

Anigozanthos 'Big Red' Grasses and clumping plants
Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant 1- 1.5mH x 1-1.5mW with strap-like leaves. Tall stems of bright scarlet flowers in spring. Requires draining soils in full or part sun.

Anigozanthos 'Orange Cross' Grasses and clumping plants
Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant 1.2mH x 1.5mW, strappy leaves. Vivid orange flowers late spr & sum. Moist to dry well-drained soils, full to part sun. Recovers from frost damage. Water weekly in dry winter.

Anigozanthos 'Yellow Gem' Grasses and clumping plants Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant 1- 1.5mH x 1-1.5mW with strap-like leaves. Tall stems of yellow flowers in spring. Requires well-drained soils in full or part sun with protection from heavy frosts.

Arthropodium sp. B Grasses and clumping plants Vanilla Lily. 0.3mH x 0.3mW. Grass like leaves, pretty pale lilac flowers on long stems to 0.8mH Nov-Feb. Anthers pale green. Most conditions in shade or part sun. Dies back in winter. Tubers can be eaten. Good in pots.

Banksia baxteri Medium shrub Birds' Nest Banksia. A dense spreading shrub 3-4mH x 3mW, triangular lobed leaves. Showy lemony flower cones spring-autumn. For well-drained light to heavy soils in partial to full sun. Frost protection when young.

Banksia cunninghamii (gold/black) Large shrub, Tree Tall shrub to 6mH x 3mW with hairy branchlets and narrow toothed leaves, pale below. Attractive yellow flowerheads with black spines, in autumn. For well-drained acid soils in sun or part shade. Attracts birds.

Banksia integrifolia Tree Small to medium tree to 10mH x 5mW. Silver foliage. Yellow spike flowers in autumn and winter. Most soils and aspects suitable. Good for coastal plantings. Bird attracting.

Banksia menziesii Large shrub A compact shrub to 2mH x 3mW, oblong toothed leaves. Flowerheads silvery red with golden styles Feb-Aug. Warm sunny spot, light to medium draining soil. Drought hardy. Spectacular flower.

Banksia robur Medium shrub Swamp Banksia. Medium shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Attractive reddish new growth. Stiff oaklike leaves, greenish flowers ageing to yellow all year. Sunny position. Adapts to a variety of sites and soils. Likes extra water but will withstand quite dry periods.

Banksia spinulosa Large shrub Bushy shrub 2-4mH x 2-4mW with narrow toothed leaves, pale below. Honey coloured flowers with purplish spines in autumn/winter. Suits well-drained acid soils in sun or part shade. Suitable under Eucalypts. Bird plant.

Beaufortia sparsa Medium shrub Upright medium shrub 2mH x 2mW with many small narrow leaves. Brilliant red bottlebrush flowers in summer. Sunny well-drained position with shelter from frost. Prune after flowering.

Boronia megastigma Container plant Brown Boronia. Shrub to 1.5mH x 0.6mW. Fine aromatic foliage; fragrant spring flowers, dark brown with yellow inside. Permanently moist, well-drained soil. Cool root run in shade. Wind protection. Containers. Short lived.

Anigozanthos flavidus (bright red) Grasses and clumping plants Kangaroo Paw. Vigorous clumping plant to 1mH x 1mW with thick strappy leaves. Tubular vibrant red flowers on 2m stems Nov- Feb. For light to medium soils in partial to full sun. Recovers from frost damage.

Baloskion tetraphyllum Grasses and clumping plants Creeping plant with erect stems to 1mH with finely divided plume-like branches. Grow in full sun in damp soil near or in water. Feature foliage plant for pots, and floral arrangements.

Banksia burdettii Medium shrub A much branched medium sized shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Spectacular bright orange flowers are borne at the end of branches. Prefers sandy or well drained acid soils. Drought and frost tolerant when established

Banksia ericifolia (dwarf) Small shrub Medium bushy shrub to 2mH x 1mW. Bright green linear leaves, cylindrical orange flowers. Hardy screen or hedge plant in most positions with moist well-drained soil. Bird attracting.

Banksia marginata Large shrub Large shrub to small tree 3-5mH x 2-3mW. Silver backed foliage. Yellow flowers in autumn and winter. Most well-drained positions. Tolerates some shade. Hardy banksia.

Banksia pilostylis Container plant Bushy medium shrub to 4mH x 3mW with slender saw toothed leaves. Creamy yellow scented flowers to 12cm in spring. Needs good drainage and full sun with frost protection in its first year.

Banksia speciosa Large shrub Showy Banksia. Many branching shrub to 4m. Very long leaves with triangular lobes. Showy lemon cream flower cones spring-autumn. For well-drained light to heavy soils in partial to full sun. Frost protection when young.

Banksia undata var. splendens Large shrub syn Dryandra praemorsa. Bushy medium shrub 2-4mH x 2-4mW with long, toothed foliage. Yellow or pink flowers in spring. Prefers well-drained soil in dappled shade or part sun. Useful screening plant. Bird attracting.

Blandfordia grandiflora Container plant Christmas Bells. Small narrow leaved tufty plant to 0.5mH x 0.4mW. Tall stems with groups of large waxy scarlet and gold bells in late spring-summer. Moist or wet well drained soils in full or filtered sun. Very good container plant.

Brachyscome 'Amethyst' Groundcover Small plant 0.15mH x 0.6mW. Rounded ground cover. Green finely divided leaves, deep, bluish violet daisy flowers during spring, summer and autumn. Full sun to partial shade in most soils. Prune old stems in early spring.





Brachyscome 'Pilliga Posy' Groundcover
Prostrate suckering plant with lobed leaves. Pink daisy flowers in spring and autumn. Full sun to partial shade in a mulched draining garden. Prefers some moisture. For best show prune away old stems in late winter.

Brachyscome multifida (pink) Groundcover
Small plant 0.15mH x 0.6mW. Rounded ground cover. Green finely divided leaves, pink daisy flowers during spring, summer and autumn. Moist soils in partial shade. For best show prune away old stems in late winter.

Callistemon 'Eureka' Large shrub
Erect dense shrub to 3mH x 2mW with narrow leaves and purplish-red new growth. Masses of long slender bright pink flowers in spring. Suitable for most garden conditions. Striking plant.

Callistemon pachyphyllus var viridus Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with fine green leaves. Interesting green flower spikes in spring and autumn. Will accept most soils and bad drainage but needs full sun. Prune heavily after flowering.

Callistemon pearsonii 'Rocky Rambler' Groundcover
Prostrate-0.3mH x 1.5mW. Deep red brushes with golden anthers in summer. For acidic soils in sun to semi- shade. May get tip damage from heavy frost.

Callistemon sieberi Large shrub
River bottlebrush. Large shrub to 3mH x 2mW with narrow leaves and cream flowers in summer. Hardy in most conditions with part or full sun. Prune to keep shape and promote flowering.

Callistemon viminalis Tree
Weeping tree 6mH x 3mW with narrow leaves. Silky new growth. Long red brushes in spring, summer and autumn. Prune for autumn flowers. Takes wide range of soils in full sun. Not for frost hollows.

Calothamnus quadrifidus (yellow) Medium shrub
Upright shrub to 2mH x 2mW with pine-like leaves. Creamy-yellow flowers in one-sided spikes in spring/summer. Adapts to most well-drained soils in full or part sun. Protect from frost when young. Attracts birds.

Carex appressa Grasses and clumping plants
Tall Sedge. A clumping tussock which may grow to 0.8mH with brown flowerheads in spring and summer. It grows well in most positions even water logging, in full sun. It can handle dry periods. Strong roots good for erosion control.

Casuarina glauca prostrate Groundcover
Cousin It - Cascading ground cover without flowers. Long dark green needle-like foliage, spreading from a rounded mound. Most soils, full or part sun. Excellent in rockeries as it will cascade over rocks.

Brachyscome ciliaris linear Grasses and clumping plants
Small upright grassland plant 0.4 mH x 0.2mW. Light green linear leaves, with large mauve/pink daisy flowers all year. Full sun to part shade in most draining soils. For best show prune away old stems in early spring.

Bulbine semibarbata Grasses and clumping plants
Leek Lily. Small perennial herb to 0.5mH x 0.1-0.3mW with succulent light green leaves. Many stems of yellow flowers to 1.4cm across in spring and summer. For most soils in sun to dappled shade. Good regeneration from seed.

Callistemon 'Mauve Mist' Large shrub
An outstanding shrub to 4mH x 2-4mW, with very silky new growth and leaves tapering at both ends. Mauve bottlebrush flowers in late spring to summer. Suitable for most soils and conditions. Good screen. Cultivar

Callistemon pallidus Large shrub
Erect large shrub 3mH x 2mW, sometimes taller. Elliptical leaves. Creamy yellow flowers in summer and autumn. Suited to most soils in sunny position. Prune after flowering. Hardy species.

Callistemon pinifolius (red) Medium shrub
Open medium shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW with very narrow sharply pointed leaves. Red flower spikes in summer. Full sun. Hardy and adaptable to most conditions, even poor soils. Prune for shape regularly after flowering.

Callistemon sieberi Mt Mistake Large shrub
Hardy shrub 1.2mH x 1.2mW with pendulous grey green foliage. Pink flowers with yellow anthers in summer and sporadically during warmer months. For part or full sun. Prune to keep shape and promote flowering.

Calothamnus quadrifidus (grey leaf) Medium shrub
Common Net Bush. Upright shrub 3mH x 5mW. Grey pine-like hairy leaves. Red flowers in one-sided spikes in spr/sum. Most well-drained soils in full or part sun. Protect from frost when young. Bird plant.

Calotis cuneifolia Groundcover
Low spreading daisy to 0.3mH x 0.5mW with wedge-shaped leaves and hairy branches. Mauve flowers most of year, small burr fruits. Hardy in most soils. Partial to full sun. Prune old stems in late winter. Rockery plant.

Casuarina cunninghamiana Tree
River Sheoak. Shelter or shade tree to 20mH x 12mW. Needle-like foliage, woody cones. Flowers Dec-Jan. Most soils, well- drained or damp, full sun. Grows on riverbanks. Controls soil by suckering. Very fast growing.

Chamelaucium 'Paddy's Pink' Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with fine light green leaves. Crowded blueish pink flowers late spring, early summer. Light to medium draining soils in sun or part shade. Great cut flower. Drought and frost hardy.





Chamelaucium uncinatum (pink) Large shrub
Geraldton Wax. Open shrub to 3mH x 4mW with linear leaves.
Large open pink flowers in spring. Perfect drainage in sandy soils.
Regular pruning. Some frost protection. Excellent cut flower.

Chorizema cordatum Small shrub
Flame Pea. Small shrub 1mH x 0.5mW with heart-shaped leaves.
Weak branches supported by other shrubs. Orange and pink pea
flowers in spring. Sandy well- mulched soils. Dappled shade or part
sun. Slightly frost tender.

Convolvulus angustissimus Climber
Small plant 0.1H x 0.5mW with a trailing habit. Rosy pink flowers
Oct-Mar. Good mulch substitute suppressing weeds..Drought hardy

Correa 'Bilby Bells' Small shrub
Open, upright shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW with grey-green leaves.
Large bright red bells with lime-green tips in aut/win/spring. Needs
a draining site in part sun or dappled shade. Tolerates dry periods
when established. Tip prune.

Correa 'Bindaga Pink' Small shrub
Small shrub 0.75mH x 1.5mW. Dark green oval leaves with pink
flowers from late Autumn through winter. Dry or moist draining
soils in shade or semi shade. Frost hardy. Bird attracting.
Bred by Bilby Blooms

Correa 'Kiss me Kate' Groundcover, Small shrub
Small dense shrub 0.6mH x 2mW with rounded leaves. Pink bells
in autumn and winter. For draining clay soils in moist or dry
conditions in part sun or shade. Long flowering, attracts birds.
Prune regularly.

Correa 'White Tips' Small shrub
Shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW . Very pretty pink bells with white tips in
autumn and winter. For draining soils in moist or dry conditions in
full sun or shade. Attracts birds. Prune regularly.

Crowea exalata Small shrub
Rounded hardy shrub to 0.7mH x 0.7mW. Linear leaves and star-
like white to pink flowers in autumn and spring. Most positions in
well-drained mulched soils. Good pot plant.

Cymbopogon refractus Grasses and clumping plants
Barbed Wire Grass. Aromatic perennial grass, tufted to 0.4mH. Tall
stems, to 1mH, with reddish, hairy flowers which bend back when
mature resembling 'Barbed-wire'. For dry sites on poor soils in sun
or some shade.

Derwentia arenaria Small shrub
Small to medium shrub 0.6-1.5mH x 1- 2mW with narrow leaves.
Pale to deep violet-blue flowers are profuse and conspicuous from
Sept-May. For moderately well-drained acidic soils in sun or semi-
shade. Rare plant.

Cheilanthes distans Grasses and clumping plants
Resurrection Fern. Attractive upright clump 0.1-0.3mH with broad
green crowded fronds. Accepts situations in sun or shade, with
reasonable drainage. Will go dormant during extended dry
periods, re-appearing after rain

Chrysocephalum apiculatum (suckering)
Groundcover
Perennial herb with slender grey leaves 0.2mH x 0.5-2mW.
Clusters of small golden flowers all the year. Reasonable drainage
and sun. Prune in spring. Good in massed plantings.

Correa 'Barossa Gold' Medium shrub
Syn C glabra var. turnbullii. Rounded small to medium shrub
1.5mH x 1.5mW with elliptic leaves that age to gold. Red & green
bell flowers from Nov-April. Well-drained soils in dappled shade or
part sun. Prune. Ornamental.

Correa 'Bilby Blush' Small shrub
Small shrub 1mH x 1mW with dark green leaves and upright habit.
Large red bell flowers autumn to spring. Draining soils in shade or
full sun. Bird plant. Frost and drought hardy.
Bred by Bilby Blooms

Correa 'Dusky Bells' Groundcover, Small shrub
Small dense shrub 0.6mH x 2mW with oval leaves. Dusky pink
bells in autumn and winter. For heavy and clay soils in moist or dry
conditions in full sun or shade. Long flowering, attracts birds.
Prune regularly.

Correa 'White Lies' Groundcover, Small shrub
Small dense shrub 0.4mH x 2mW with oval leaves. Pure white
flared bells in autumn and winter. For draining soils in moist or dry
conditions in full sun or shade. Attracts birds. Prune regularly.
Bred by Bilby Blooms

Correa glabra (red) Medium shrub
Rounded shrub 1.2-1.8mH x 1.2-2mW. Smooth glossy leaves, red
bell flowers in winter. Well-drained soil in half or full shade. Good
screen, attracts birds.

Crowea saligna Small shrub
Small shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with elliptic leaves. Pink star-like
flowers in autumn and winter, and sporadic. Part sun in most
relatively well-drained soils, if well mulched. Ornamental plant.
Good cut flower. Semi shaded position best.

Dampiera diversifolia Groundcover
Prostrate herb x 1mW. Small toothed leaves. Purple-blue flowers
spr/sum. Well drained moist soils in full or part sun. May be
affected by heavy frost but recovers well. Spectacular in container
or hanging basket.

Derwentia perfoliata Small shrub
Perennial to 0.6mH x 1mW with arching stems of grey green ovate
leaves. Terminal sprays of bright blue flowers in summer. Full sun
to part shade. Very hardy. Prune off old stems late winter.





Dianella 'Currabubula' Grasses and clumping plants
Blue Berry Lily. Attractive plant with grey blue leaves to 0.75mH x 1mW. Pale blue flowers along 1m upright stems in spring & summer, develop into profuse large showy bright blue tasty fruits. Accepts most soils and aspects

Dianella longifolia 'Warrumbungle Rain' Grasses and clumping plants
A tight clumping plant to 0.4mH. Pale blue flowers in spring are followed by pale berries over summer. Frost and drought tolerant.

Dianella revoluta Grasses and clumping plants
Spreading Flax Lily. Tufted plant with flax- like leaves, suckering to form clumps to 2.5mW. Bright blue flowers on branched stems, bright blue fruits. Very hardy. Ideal garden plant esp. for rockeries.

Diplolaena angustifolia Small shrub
Striking shrub 1-2mH x 1-1.5mW with narrow leaves. Pendent orange-red flowers in hairy green bracts in spr-sum. Semi-hardy in part sun or dappled shade in most well-drained soils. Mulch well. Great pot plant. Not well known.

Eremophila debilis Groundcover
Syn Myoporum debilis Prostrate ground cover x 1mW. Long narrow leaves. Pink flowers in spr/sum then edible berries. Accepts most soils in filtered of full sun. Takes drought and moderate frost.

Eremophila glabra 'Belalla Gold' Groundcover
Prostrate plant 0.2mH x 2mW with bright green leaves, abundant yellow flowers from autumn to spring. Bird & bee attractant. Drought and frost tolerant. For draining soils in full or part sun.

Eremophila glabra (low grey) Groundcover
Small plant to 0.5mH to 1.5mW with grey leaves. Masses of yellow flowers from winter to summer and sporadic. For most draining soils in full to part sun. Drought and frost hardy. Can be pruned hard.

Eremophila maculata 'Aurea' Small shrub
Vigorous small shrub 0.9mH x 1-2mW with dark green leaves and bright lime-yellow flowers that are well-displayed. Good drainage and sun or semi-shade are best. Will tolerate heavy soils. Responds to pruning.

Eremophila maculata (cerise) Small shrub, Medium shrub
Variable shrub 1mH x 1.5mW. Small often sticky leaves, tubular cerise flowers in winter-spring. For heavier soils with good drainage in part to full sun. Tip prune young plants for bushy growth.

Eremophila maculata x racemosa Medium shrub
Medium upright shrub to 1.5mH. Yellow then orange buds open to pink flowers with a white fringe inside the throat of the flower. For a wide range of soils in full to part sun. Prune to shape. Bird attractant.

Dianella 'Uralla' Grasses and clumping plants
Mini Flax Lily. Tufted plant with flax- like leaves, suckering to form clumps to 1mW. Bright blue flowers on branched stems, bright blue fruits. Very hardy. Ideal garden plant especially for rockeries, great border plant.

Dianella longifolia var. longifolia Grasses and clumping plants
A tufty plant to 0.3-0.7mH x 0.5mW. Flower spikes to 1.5m with pale blue flowers in spring; small purple berries follow. For a wide variety of soils in full sun to part shade or a spot with other small shrubs.

Dichondra repens Groundcover
Prostrate herb 1-2mW rooting at the nodes, with kidney-shaped leaves and tiny cream-green flowers in spring-summer. Very hardy ground cover in a wide range of conditions. Lawn alternative for low traffic.

Eremophila 'Passionate Lady' Medium shrub
E bigonifolia x alternifolia Large shrub 3mH x 3mW (growth is restricted by pruning). Bright- green leaves & hot pink flowers Sept-May. For a hot, sunny site for a wide range of soils. Frost and drought tolerant.

Eremophila glabra 'Augusta Storm' Small shrub
Small plant 0.3-0.5mH x 1.2mW with grey-green leaves. Purple flowers late winter to summer and sporadic. For a wide range of draining soils in full to part sun. Can be pruned hard.

Eremophila glabra (burgundy prostrate) Groundcover
Small plant to 1.5mW with grey-green leaves. Glossy burgundy flowers late winter to summer and sporadic. For a wide range of draining soils in full to part sun. Can be pruned hard.

Eremophila glabra var. carnosa Small shrub
Small upright shrub to 1mH x 0.5mW, with small green leaves. Flowers scarlet with yellow throat in spring, summer & autumn. For draining soils in an open spot. Prune to shape. Bird attractant.

Eremophila maculata 'Pink Passion' Medium shrub
Shrub 1mH x 1mW. Small leaves, tubular rich pink flowers in winter-spring. Best in heavier soils with drainage in part to full sun. Provides nectar for birds. Frost and very drought hardy.

Eremophila maculata (hot pink) Small shrub
Small spreading shrub 1mH x 1.5mW with small often sticky leaves and tubular hot pink flowers in winter-spring. For heavier soils with good drainage in part to full sun. Tip prune for bushy growth.

Eucalyptus 'Big Hybrid Red' Large shrub
Upright mallee shrub 2-3mH x 2-3mW, with opposite silvery leaves. The large silver buds, in threes, are followed by showy red flowers (10cm) throughout year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant





Eucalyptus 'Carnabyi' Large shrub
Mallee to 4.5mH. *E. youngiana* x *E. pyriformis*. Bark smooth and orange brown with pale blue green leaves. Spectacular clusters of large salmon flowers. Tolerates dryness & frost. Needs reasonable drainage.

Eucalyptus 'Jaq Joy' Large shrub
Mallee to 4.5mH. *E. youngiana* x *E. macrocarpa*. Bark smooth and orange brown with pale blue green leaves. Spectacular clusters of large salmon red flowers. Tolerates dryness & frost. Needs reasonable drainage. **Bred by Bilby Blooms**

Eucalyptus 'Silver Princess' *Eucalyptus albens*
Tree
Eucalyptus caesia subsp. *magna*. Mallee 8-15mH x 3-5mW, decorative bark, pendulous branches, glaucous foliage & large red flowers June-Nov. For fairly well- drained acid to slightly alkaline soils, sunny site. Frost protection when young.

Eucalyptus blakelyi Tree
Medium tree to 20mH x 10-15mW with short straight trunk & widely spreading crown. White flowers Aug-Dec. Adapts to many soil types. For shade, woodlots & windbreaks on farms. Good Koala tree.

Eucalyptus cladocalyx nana Tree
A dwarf variety of Sugar Gum 7-10mH with dense bushy habit and smooth grey bark. Profuse white flowers in summer attract nectar feedig birds. Tolerates dry conditions and moderate frosts. Responds well to pruning or coppicing. Ideal screen or windbreak

Eucalyptus forrestiana Large shrub
Moderately growing mallet to 3mH. Many yellow flowers are borne from bright red buds in the summer. Accepts most soils to heavy loams. Frost and wind resistant and drought tolerant. Withstands occasional waterlogging

Eucalyptus leucoxylon subsp. rosea Tree
Small tree 6-8mH x 5-6mW, clean bark, long leaves. Large, deep pink flowers during year. Most dry or moist reasonably drained soils in full or part sun. Withstands dry periods.

Eucalyptus macrocarpa sbp. elachantha Container plant
Sprawling mallee shrub 2-4mH, with rounded silvery leaves. The large glaucous buds are followed by showy pink- red flowers. Requires reasonable drainage in open sunny site.

Eucalyptus macrorhyncha Tree
Red stringy bark. Small to medium sized tree to 20m, with rough, thick fibrous and stringy dark brown bark. Grows on a wide range of soil though prefers draining clay. Drought and frost tolerant.

Eucalyptus pulverulenta Tree
Small twisted tree to 4mH with silver-grey stem-clasping foliage. White flowers from Sept-Nov. Hardy in sun in well-drained soils. May be pruned hard or coppiced. Good foliage contrast, used in floral arrangements.

Eucalyptus 'Delicious' Medium shrub
Mallee 1.5m-3mH x 1-3mW. This small ornamental eucalypt has beautiful huge red coloured buds and red flowers throughout the year. Drought and frost tolerant on non water logging soils. Prune hard to rejuvenate.

Eucalyptus 'Little Princess' Tree
Mallee to 3mH x 3mW. Decorative bark, upright habit, grey foliage & large pink flowers June-Nov. Draining acid to slightly alkaline soils. Full to part sun. Protect from heavy frost when young.
Bred by Bilby Blooms

Eucalyptus albens Tree
White Box. Med/large tree 15-25mH x 10- 15mW. Fibrous flaky grey bark, grey-green leaves, white flowers in autumn, winter. Widespread in woodland. Grows in a wide range of soils.

Eucalyptus cinerea Tree
Argyle Apple. Medium tree 8-15mH x 8-15mW. Attractive glaucous cordate juvenile foliage, and glaucous adult foliage. White flowers Oct-Dec. Adapts to most well-drained soils. Responds to hard pruning and coppicing. Great foliage.

Eucalyptus crebra Tree
Tree to 30mH x 15mW with grey corrugated bark and narrow lance-shaped dull-green leaves. White flowers in panicles May-Jan, very small buds and fruit. Well drained dry heavy soils. Shelter belts, woodlots. Slow growing.

Eucalyptus gillii Medium shrub
Silver Mallee. Small shrubby mallee to 2mH x 3mW, with decorative trunk and attractive silvery foliage. Profuse pale yellow flowers June-Dec. For draining soils. Drought and frost hardy.

Eucalyptus macrocarpa Container plant
Sprawling mallee shrub 1-4mH x 1-4mW, with opposite large silvery leaves. The glaucous buds are followed by showy pink- red flowers (10cm) throughout the year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant

Eucalyptus macrocarpa x youngiana Large shrub
Upright mallee shrub 2-3mH x 2-3mW, with opposite glaucous leaves. The large silver buds, in threes, are followed by showy clusters of red flowers (up to 10cm) throughout year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant

Eucalyptus melliodora Tree
Yellow Box. Handsome tree 10-20mH x 8- 20mW with attractive trunk. Blue-grey leaves and cream flowers in autumn. Takes dry or moist well-drained soils in full sun. Well known for it's beautiful honey.

Eucalyptus punctata Tree
Orange Gum. Med tree to 35mH x 15mW. Smooth grey-white bark sheds in large plates, shows attractive orange trunk. White flowers in sum. For dry or moist well- drained soils in filtered or full sun. Good specimen tree. ST plant.





Eucalyptus sideroxylon 'Pretty Pink' Tree
Mugga Ironbark. Medium tree 3-8mH x 4- 6mW with dark, deeply fissured bark. Greyish leaves, pretty pink flowers in winter and spring. Accepts a wide range of soils. Frost, drought and salt tolerant.

Eucalyptus staigeriana Large shrub
Lemon scented Ironbark. Slender upright small eucalypt to 3mH. Crushed leaves give a sweet lemon smell, can be used in cooking/teas. Accepts most soils to heavy loams. Frost, wind and drought tolerant.

Eucalyptus woodwardii Large shrub, Tree
Lemon flowered gum. Small tree or mallee 6 - 15mH. Attractive smooth cream bark. Pretty bright yellow flowers June-Nov. For most soils in a warm sunny spot. Drought hardy, protect from frost when young.

Eucalyptus youngiana x macrocarpa Container plant
Upright mallee shrub 2-3mH x 2-3mW, with opposite silvery leaves. The large silver buds, in threes, are followed by showy red flowers (10cm) throughout year. Accepts most draining soils. Frost and drought tolerant

Goodenia varia Small shrub
Small shrub 0.1-0.6mH x 0.5-1.5mW with oblong, usually toothed, foliage. Yellow flowers are sporadic throughout the year. Likes well-drained soils in sun. Responds to pruning. Good for hanging baskets, or embankments

Grevillea 'Apricot Charm' Medium shrub
Hardy dense medium shrub to 1.5mH x 2mW. Glossy green leaves with pendulous apricot flowers during winter and spring. For non flooding soils, full sun to part shade. Frost hardy.

Grevillea 'Carpet Queen' Groundcover
Dense groundcover 0.3-0.6mH x 1-1.8mW, with small deep-green leaves. Apricot flowers mainly in spring. For well-drained light to medium soils in full or part sun. Give low phosphorus fertilizer in spring. Good bird plant.

Grevillea 'Flora Mason' Medium shrub
Vigorous medium shrub to 3mH x 2mW. Masses of beautiful lemon to pink flowers are a feature from late Autumn to early Spring. Accepts full sun to part shade, in clay to sandy loams. Drought and frost tolerant.

Grevillea 'Iced VoVo' Large shrub
Large shrub 2.5mH x 3mW. Long deeply lobed leaves with pale and deep pink toothbrush flowers in spring and summer. Well drained site in sun or semi-shade. Excellent quick growing screen plant. Nesting sites for birds.

Grevillea 'Poorinda Rondeau' Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1.5-2mH x 1.5-3mW, with shiny dark-green oval leaves. Showy, profuse bright pinkish-red flowers July-Nov. For most well-drained acid soils in sun. Hardy to most frosts. Prune lightly for good shape.

Eucalyptus sideroxylon var. rosea Tree
Tree 10-20mH x 5-10mW, ornamental blue green foliage, black bark & attractive pink flowers May-Oct. For a wide range of soils conditions. Frost, drought and salt tolerant.

Eucalyptus trachyphloia Tree
Handsome medium tree to 15mH with rough tessellated flaky brown bark. Terminal white to cream inflorescences during summer to early autumn. Suitable for free draining soils. Frost and drought hardy.

Eucalyptus youngiana Medium shrub
Mallee 1.5m-4mH x 1-3mW. This small ornamental eucalypt is known for the beautiful huge buds and red flowers throughout the year. Drought and frost tolerant on non water logging soils. Prune hard to rejuvenate.

Gastrolobium celsianum Small Shrub
Syn Brachysema c-. Dense spreading shrub to 1mH x 2mW, dark-green lance- shaped leaves, silver-backed. Showy red pea flowers June-Oct and sporadic. For fairly well-drained situations with some overhead cover. Bird plant.

Grevillea 'Amethyst' Small shrub
Decorative small shrub to 1mH with fine prickly foliage. Showy pink flowers in spring & summer. For most soils in sun or part sun. Good for small birds.

Grevillea 'Carol Ann' Medium shrub
Decumbent spreading shrub to 2mW. Dense non prickly foliage with an occasional upright branch. Dark red flowers are borne most of the year. For sun or semi-shade in most draining soils. Frost and drought hardy. Good for birds.

Grevillea 'Charming Red' Medium shrub
Hardy dense medium shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Dark green oval leaves with pendulous red flowers during winter and spring. For non flooding soils, full sun to part shade. Frost hardy.

Grevillea 'Hills Jubilee' Medium shrub
Dense compact green shrub 1.2mH x 1mW. Striking white & red/pink spider flowers from Autumn to Spring & periodic. Most soils and positions. Prune hard for hedge. Frost hardy. Good bird attractant.

Grevillea 'New Blood' Groundcover
A low, spreading shrub .25mH x 1.5mW, which flowers for most of the year. The flowers are deep red and bird attracting. Great as a feature ground cover plant for rockeries and banks as well as for pots. Grows in draining soils from sandy to clay. Drought and frost hardy.

Grevillea 'Red Sunset' Medium shrub
Fast growing medium shrub 1 - 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Masses of red spider flowers are borne from Winter to Spring. Tolerates clay and lime. Drought and frost tolerant.





Grevillea 'Winpara Gem' Medium shrub
Upright shrub 2-3.5mH x 2mW with finely divided grey-green leaves and orange red spider flowers in win/spr. For dry or moist well drained site in full or part sun. Not for frost hollows. Tolerates lime. Prune regularly.

Grevillea beadleana Medium shrub
Dense spreading shrub 1.5mH x 2.5mW with soft, grey-green, much divided leaves. Dark-red toothbrush flowers most of year. Most well-drained soils in sun or dappled shade. Screen or hedge, attracts birds.

Grevillea iaspicula Medium shrub
A medium shrub 1.5-2.5mH x 1.5-3mW with narrow light green foliage. Cream and red flowers from May-Nov. For draining soils in sun to semi-shade. Prune for bushy growth. Rare and endangered plant.

Grevillea juniperina 'Molonglo' Small shrub
Low spreading shrub 0.5mH x 3mW with small narrow prickly foliage. Apricot flowers in spring and summer. Good drainage in most soils and full sun for best flowering. Vigorous grower. Good ground cover. Bird attracting.

Grevillea olivacea (red) Medium shrub
An evergreen fast growing shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Masses of red flowers in winter and spring. Tolerates wide range of soil types including limestone and clay. Drought and frost hardy.

Grevillea semperflorens Medium shrub, Large shrub
An early hybrid Grevillea to 2mH x 2mW. Pink and apricot flowers a seen most of the year on arching branches of grey green leaves. Tolerates acid neutral clay or loam soils. Frost and drought hardy

Grevillea x gaudichaudii Groundcover
Vigorous ground cover 0.1mH x 3mW. Oak- like leaves, dark red toothbrush flowers in late spring and summer. Reliable in well-drained sunny position. Recommended.

Hakea francisiana Large shrub
Erect shrub 5mH x 3mW with long leaves. Attractive spikes of hot pink flowers in winter to spring. Dry sunny warm spot in light-med soils with good drainage. Prune when young for windy sites. Attracts birds. Drought, lime and frost hardy when established.

Hakea laurina Large shrub
Pincushion Hakea. Erect or weeping shrub to 4mH x 4mW, long oblong leaves. Showy round heads of red and cream flowers, autumn & winter. For a sunny draining site. Not for frost hollows.

Hakea nitida Medium shrub
A medium shrub to 1mH x 2mW. Firm broad leaves have sharp teeth which help make this plant a good screener. Masses of perfumed white flowers occur in late winter. Full to partial sun in draining soils. Frost hardy

Grevillea 'Winter Delight' Small shrub
Hardy groundcover to 0.3mH x 1.5mW. Lovely small soft grey leaves with clusters of red and cream flowers in winter and spring. Tolerates clay and well drained soils. Drought and frost hardy.

Grevillea flexuosa Large shrub
Spectacular, vigorous large shrub 2mH x 2mW. Deeply lobed leaves and unusual cream fragrant flowers during spring. Reasonably drained site in sun or semi-shade. Excellent quick growing screen plant. Nesting sites for birds.

Grevillea juniperina 'Molonglo Stripy' Small shrub
Low spreading shrub 0.5mH x 3mW with small narrow variegated prickly foliage. Apricot flowers in spring and summer. Good drainage in most soils. Full sun for best flowering. Good ground cover.

Grevillea lanigera (Mt Tamboritha) Groundcover
Prostrate shrub to 2mW. Neat grey-green leaves, red and cream flowers in autumn, winter and spring. Dry or moist well-drained soils in filtered or full sun. Small groundcover or rockery plant. Attracts birds.

Grevillea rosmarinifolia Medium shrub
Variable shrub 0.3-3mH x 1-5mW with narrow prickly foliage. Red and cream spider flowers in late winter. Most soils and positions. Prune hard for hedge. Very hardy. Good bird attractant. Can invade bushland.

Grevillea willisii Medium shrub
Spreading shrub 2.5mH x 3mW. Prickly divided grey leaves, spikes of white 'toothbrush' flowers in spring and summer. Full or filtered sun with reasonable drainage. Hardy quick growing screen or tall ground cover.

Hakea 'Tessa' Large shrub
H. multilineata x *grammatophylla* A variable shrub to 2.5mH, with narrow grey-green leaves to 16cm long. Showy crimson pink scented flowers appear in the leaf axils from March to August. Draining soils in a sunny to part shaded site. Drought and frost hardy.

Hakea grammatophylla Medium shrub
A small variable shrub up to 2mH, with narrow grey-green leaves up to 16cm long, with finely striated veins. Showy red scented flowers appear in the leaf axils from March to August. Drought and frost hardy.

Hakea macraeana Large shrub
Large shrub 4mH x 3.5mW. Soft needle like foliage. Cream perfumed flowers in leaf axils in spring. Most draining soils in full sun to semi-shade. Excellent hardy screen plant. Rare and endangered.

Hakea orthorrhyncha Medium shrub
Rounded shrub to 1.5-2.5mH x 1-3mW with long needle like leaves. Spectacular red flowers on older wood in winter and spring. Tolerant of a wide range of soils, moist or dry, in full or filtered sun. Showy in flower.





Hakea petiolaris Large shrub

Tall shrub 3mH x 2mW with rounded grey-green leaves. Green/pink sea urchin flowers aging to cream/maroon in autumn and winter. Needs reasonable drainage and plenty of sun. Prune lightly.

Hardenbergia violacea Groundcover, Climber
Ground cover or trailing plant to 1.5mW with lance-shaped leaves. Masses of purple flowers in spring. Full sun to partly shaded draining position. May be pruned hard. Not for frost hollows.

Helichrysum rutidolepis Groundcover
Spreading plant 0.15-0.4mH x 0.5-1mW with soft linear foliage and hairy new growth. Very showy golden-yellow flowerheads Feb-April. Wide range of positions and soil types. Remove spent flowers. Dies back in winter.

Hymenanthera dentata Medium shrub
Tree Violet. Rigid shrub to 2mH x 1mW, crowded linear leaves on short spiny branchlets. Strongly fragrant small tubular yellow flowers Aug-Nov. For a wide range of well-drained soils in sun to semi-shade.

Isopogon anethifolius Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1-2.5mH x 1-2.5mW. Divided leaves with very narrow leaflets. Yellow globe-shaped flowers July-Dec. Most acidic soils suitable, not waterlogged. Some shade. Tip prune young plants. Good cut flower.

Isopogon formosus Small shrub
Rounded shrub, 1.5mH x 1.5mW, with narrow divided leaves. Large terminal heads of pink flowers in winter-spring followed by globular cones. Needs well-drained soils (raised bed), in sun or semi-shade.

Kennedia nigricans Climber
A vigorous climber or ground cover with lobed dark green leaves and attractive black and yellow pea flowers. Fast growing, useful for quick coverage of ugly fences or banks. Hardy plant, tolerant of drought, light frost and shade.

Kunzea parvifolia Medium shrub
Spreading plant 2mH x 2mW with tiny heath like foliage. Very pretty mauve fluffy flowers in spring. For most soils in full or filtered sun. Spring spectacle. Very hardy.

Leptospermum 'Pink Cascade' Small shrub
Small shrub 0.5-1mH x 1-1.5mW, dark green pointed leaves. Reddish buds open to pink flowers in spring & often in autumn. It is adaptable in most soils in sun & semi-shade. May be clipped or pruned.

Lomandra longifolia (grey leaf) Grasses and clumping plants
A dense tussock plant 0.5-1mH x 0.6-1mW. Creamy, often fragrant flowers in Aug-Dec and then brown shiny fruits. For most well-drained soils with some sun. Feature with shrubs or grasses.

Hakea platysperma Medium shrub
Cricket Ball Hakea. Rounded shrub 1.5mH x 2mW with long needle-like leaves and clusters of fragrant flowers, cream, aging to red, in axils in spring. Very large ornamental spherical fruits. Hardy in freely draining sites in sun.

Hardenbergia violacea (pink) Groundcover, Climber
Groundcover or trailing plant to 1.5m-2mW with lance-shaped leaves. Masses of pink flowers in spring. Full sun to partly shaded well-drained position. May be pruned hard. Some frost damage. Not for frost hollows.

Hovea lanceolata Medium shrub
Open shrub 2mH x 1mW. Narrow leaves. Blue pea flowers in late winter or spring. Likes excellent drainage, cool root run and some overhead shade. Light pruning beneficial.

Isopogon 'Coaldale Cracker' Small shrub
I. petiolaris x I. mnoraifolius. Shrub to 1.5mH x 1mW with divided foliage. Cream/yellow globe shaped flowers in spring. Grows in a wide range of soils even watering logging. Very hardy. Responds well to pruning.

Isopogon dawsonii Medium shrub
A shrub to 2.5mH x 1-2mW, with grey-green, much divided leaves. Prominent creamy-white heads of flowers in spring. For most well-drained soils and light overhead cover. Prune lightly.

Jacksonia scoparia Large shrub
A shrub to 4mH x 2mW, often tree-like in form, with pendulous, leafless branches. Profuse yellow/red pea flowers in late spring. For most reasonably drained soils in full sun to part shade.

Kunzea ambigua Large shrub
Variable shrub 1.5-3mH x 2-3mW. Narrow leaves, white or pink fluffy fragrant flowers in crowded clusters along stems in spring and summer. Hardy in full or part sun, good drainage, most soils.

Leionema elatius x lamprophyllum Medium shrub
Medium shrub to 1.5mH x 1.5mW, with small round dark green leaves. Heads of white flowers in winter/spring. Suitable for draining soils in sun and dappled shade. Wonderful small hedging plant.

Lobelia quadrangularis (sky blue) Container plant
Native Lobelia. Carpeting herb to 0.1mH x 0.8-1.0mW, linear leaves. Showy blue flowers held above foliage spr/aut. Most moist soils, full/part sun. For hanging baskets. Frost damage recovers if well established.

Melaleuca lateritia Medium shrub
Erect shrub to 2mH x 1mW with small linear leaves. Large orange-red brush flowers in late spring and summer. Hardy in well-drained soils, but likes lots of water. Flowers best in full sun.





Melaleuca micromera Medium shrub
Rounded shrub 1.5mH x 2mW with minute scale-like leaves and conifer-like habit. Small heads of yellow flowers (wattle-like) in late spring and early summer. Full sun to half shade in most reasonably drained soils.

Myoporum parvifolium Groundcover
Prostrate ground cover to 1.5-2mW with narrow fleshy leaves. White star flowers in spring and summer. Hardy in most soils in a well-drained sunny to semi-shaded position. Attractive hardy plant.

Orthrosanthus multiflorus Grasses and clumping plants
Iris-like plant to 0.4 mH with strappy light green foliage. Many spikes of blue flowers in late spring or summer. Sunny well-drained position. Hardy in most soils. Suitable for rockery.

Philotheca 'Winter Rouge' small
Small shrub .8mH x .8mW with slightly warty foliage. A profusion of white flowers follow pretty pink buds from winter to spring. For draining neutral to acid soils in sun to part shade. Prune to keep bushy.

Pittosporum angustifolium Tree
Previously P. phylliraeoides. A weeping small tree 3-8mH x 1.5-3mW, pendent green leaves. Flowers scented, cream to yellow June- Nov, followed by showy fruits. For most soils in a shady or sunny site. Frost hardy.

Prostanthera 'Bilby Ballerina' Medium shrub
Compact shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW with silvery grey leaves. Prolific pale lilac flowers with purple bases in spring. Hardy in most dry soils and conditions. Regular pruning essential. Feature plant. Frost and drought hardy.

Prostanthera nivea Large shrub
Open spreading shrub to 2mH x 2mW. Light green linear leaves, white to pale mauve flowers in spring. Good drainage in part or full sun, fast growing. Regular pruning to keep compact.

Prostanthera ovalifolia var purpurea Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1.3-2mH x 1-1.5mW, dense aromatic dark green foliage and purple flowers in profusion in spring. For moist well-drained sites in part to full shade. Good under Eucalypts. Protect from hot winds.

Prostanthera rotundifolia Large shrub
Rounded shrub 3mH x 1.5mW with fragrant leaves. Outstanding profuse purple flowers in spring. For dry and moist areas, good drainage and full or part sun without wind. Prune after flowering. Mulch well.

Pycnosorus globosus Grasses and clumping plants
Syn Craspedia globosa. Drumsticks. Robust tufty plant to 0.3mH x 0.3-0.5mW with silvery, linear leaves. Large yellow flower heads to 0.8mH in spring & summer. For most soils in sun.

Melaleuca radula Medium shrub
Medium shrub to 2.5mH x 2.5mW, linear green leaves. Profuse and showy mauve- pink flowers in spring. For medium to heavy soils in a warm, sunny spot. Drought hardy. Not for frost hollows.

Olearia lanuginosa Medium shrub
Woolly Daisy Bush. Medium shrub to 2mH x 1mW, with white branches & grey-green leaves. White flowers with mauve centres appear sum/aut. For light to medium soil in a hot, sunny site or in a pot. New to Canberra.

Pandorea pandorana (Gold) Climber
Moderately vigorous twining climber with glossy oval leaves. Golden bell flowers in spring. Well-composted soils in some shade. Fast-growing. Prune well. Some frost damage when young or in heavy frosts. Ideal screen.

Philotheca myoporoides Medium shrub
Syn Eriostemon myoporoides. Rounded medium shrub 1-2mH x 2mW with elliptical grey-green leaves. Masses of white star-like flowers, pink in bud, in spring. Reasonable drainage in most soils, full sun or shade. Very hardy.

Platysace lanceolata Small shrub
Small woody shrub to 1mH x 1mW with lanceolate bright green leaves. White flowers in umbels in summer. Hardy in most situations in filtered sun.

Prostanthera granitica Small shrub
A spreading shrub 0.6mH x 2mW with small harsh leaves. Showy purple flowers from Aug-Dec. Likes a well-drained soil with dappled shade to partial sun. Some overhead cover appreciated. Prune after flowering.

Prostanthera ovalifolia (variegata) Medium shrub
Aromatic shrub to 1.5mH x 1mW, green & cream leaves & many purple-blue flowers in spr. Prefers good drainage in light to med soils in part shade but tolerates heavy soils & dry periods. Likes the company of other plants.

Prostanthera phyllicifolia Medium shrub
Compact shrub to 1mH x 1mW with small deep green narrow leaves. Masses of violet flowers with deep purple spots in the throat in spring. Good drainage and overhead cover from hot sun.

Prostanthera sp. Dunedoo Gap Small shrub
Upright shrub to 1mH x 1mW with small aromatic hairy leaves, sometimes with maroon tinge. Mauve to purple flowers in spring. Light to medium draining soils in full sun to semi-shade. Bee attracting.

Rhagodia spinescens Groundcover, Small shrub
Spreading grey leaved plant 0.5m-1mH x 2mW with fire resistant foliage. Grows in most soils in sunny sites. Responds to pruning. Good low maintenance hedge or ground cover. Toughy. Contrast plant. Edible berries.





Ricinocarpos tuberculatus 'Bridal Star' Medium shrub
Medium shrub 2mH x 1.5mW, with narrow leaves. Masses of scented white flowers in spring and after good rain. For well-drained light to medium soils in sun or filtered shade and some overhead cover. Accent plant.

Spiranthes australis Grasses and clumping plants
Ladies Tresses. A small orchid that favours well drained moist sites, with part shade in drier sites. Hot pink flowers arranged in a spiral on the stem are a Christmas bonus.

Stylidium paniculatum Groundcover
Fragile Trigger plant. Dainty suckering perennial herb with a loose rosette of leaves at the base of short stems. Racemes of pretty pink flowers with yellow markings for most of the year. For moist draining soils in part shade. Excellent container plant.

Swainsona galegifolia (burgundy) Small shrub
Upright plant to 1.5mH with many stems of pinnate leaves. Sprays of burgundy pea flowers spr/sum/aut. For most soils (not wet) in sun. Prune old stems after flowering.

Thomasia sarotes Small shrub
Low shrub 0.8H x 1mW with rough textured grey leaves. Pink/purple small pendulous flowers in spring & autumn. For light to medium moist soils in sun to semi-shaded site. Attractive in containers or rockery.

Velleia paradoxa Grasses and clumping plants
Rosetted prostrate plant to 0.5mH x 0.3mW with elliptic leaves. Large yellow flowers in spring and summer. Well drained spot in sun or semi-shade. Needs adequate moisture in full sun. Good in rockery or container.

Westringia brevifolia var. raleighii Small shrub,
Medium shrub
Medium shrub 1.5mH x 1.5mW. Silvery grey foliage, mauve flowers all year. Very hardy with well-drained soil in sun or semi-shade. Responds to pruning for compact bushy growth. Ideal for low clipped hedge.

Westringia fruticosa 'Zena' Small shrub
Small shrub to 0.75mH x 1mW. Grey-green foliage with white flowers mainly in spring. Hardy in most soils in full sun or partial shade. Suitable for shrubbery or low hedge.

Scaevola 'Mauve Clusters' Groundcover
Suckering plant 0.2mH x 1mW with oval toothed leaves. Mauve fan flowers in clusters for long period. Hardy in all but badly drained positions. Full or part sun. Good as rockery plant or small ground cover. Mulch well.

Stylidium laricifolium Small shrub
Tree Trigger-plant. Tufty perennial sub- shrub 0.3mH but sometimes taller. The pale pink flowers are held on slender stalks above the leaves in spring and summer. For partial shade in draining soils. Good pot plant.

Stypandra glauca Grasses and clumping plants
Nodding Blue Lily. Tufting plant with blue- green leaves to 1mH x 0.6-1.2mW. Sprays of starry blue flowers with yellow anthers in spring. For well-drained soils in part shade.

Thelionema umbellatum Grasses and clumping plants
Tufted plant with grass-like leaves, 0.2mH x 0.3mW, groups of cream flowers on slender branched stems, held among leaves, in summer. Relatively well-drained soils in full or part sun. Pot or open ground.

Thryptomene calycina Medium shrub
Dense rounded shrub 2mH x 3mW. Dark green leaves, profuse small white flowers in winter and spring. Reasonable drainage, full sun or part shade, good mulch. Cut flowers. Specimen plant. Tip prune.

Westringia 52 Medium shrub
W. fruticosa x longifolia Medium shrub 2.5mH x 2mW. Dense grey-green foliage with white flowers in spring and summer. Extremely hardy fast growing screen, full sun to partial shade. Suitable for difficult positions.

Westringia fruticosa 'Smokie' Small shrub
Small shrub to 0.6-1.3mH x 1.5mW. Silver- grey leaves with cream edges, white flowers in spring and summer. Hardy for most conditions in full or part sun. Very attractive rockery plant.
